This is a gentle reminder that our school day starts promptly at 08:55am. The gates of the playground are open from 08:30am and staff are on site to supervise the children. The whistle is blown at 08:45am and children enter their classes from that time. We have a number of children who are regularly late and are therefore missing vital learning time. The education welfare officer monitors the registers for regular late arrivals.

I would also like to remind you that the collection time is currently 15:10 for KS1 or 15:20 for KS2. If you cannot pick up your child at these times on a regular basis you will need to make provision with an after school club or other outside provider to look after your child.
