European Day of Languages

We are holding our annual European Day of Languages on Thursday 22nd of September.

Children can come to school dressed in the colours of any country that speak European languages, for example Spanish, French, German etc.

We also have a continental breakfast to help celebrate this with the children. We ask that children bring in appropriate breakfast foods, bought or homemade, to share with their friends and the classes. Examples are Croissants, Pan Au Chocolate etc.

We ask that absolutely **no nuts** can be included in any of these foods and that if your child has any allergies or dietary requirements, that you send in something appropriate for them so that everyone can enjoy this fun start to the day.

Car Parking Enforcement

Nottinghamshire County Council uses CCTV cars to enforce parking outside of schools. They visit schools in Nottinghamshire and will record whilst passing, the details of any cars parked illegally. If vehicles are in parked in contravention the registered keepers will receive a Penalty Charge Notice. These restrictions are in place to provide a safe area outside of the school where the children will

gather or cross the road therefore, we ask for your help in keeping this area free of parked vehicles. The school can request enforcement from the car so, if you have any concerns regarding parking please notify us and we will arrange for a visit.

School Meals

A polite reminder to parents that any school meals need to be paid before the deadline of Friday 23rd September.

This can be paid via your parentpay account.

Could we also ask that any parents who apply for new Free School Meals places provide the confirmation paperwork to the school as soon as they receive it.

The local council only update the school once per month and as such there can be a delay gaining the information about newly registered FSMs. If you could let the office know as soon as you receive your confirmation we will be able to process this much sooner.

The Parish are asking for any help they can get for the children's Sunday Mass.

As it stands they are having to cancel the 11am mass every Sunday due to lack of support.
