Uniform

End of the Day Arrangements

As part of our safeguarding procedures, at the beginning of the school year we ensure that a teacher or teaching assistant from the previous class supports the new teacher during the end of day hand over procedure. This continuies until the teacher becomes f,iliar with parents and carers. If your child is being collected by somebody different, please communicate this through the Office by 2pm or earlier unless it is an emergency.
