## HOMEWORK

Homework will be given out every Tuesday. This needs to be returned the following Monday. It will consist of spellings, Numeracy, Reading and sometimes English, Topic or RE.
Children are encouraged to read for 20 minutes each day. This can be a combination of silent reading and reading with an adult.

Websites such as spelling shed, TT rockstars, may be used as a part of homework activities.

## HOW TO HELP YOUR CHILD.

- Encourage your child to use the correct grammar when speaking as this transfers to their writing.
- Read anything! Leaflets, posters, television guide, road signs! If children are not sure what a word means, encourage them to use a dictionary to look up the meaning and apply it to the context of the sentence.
- Practise times, tables, with them. Play games, make mistakes for them to spot and correct you.
- Encourage your child to 'teach you'.
- Have fun with your child!
